PLEASE NO ROLLING BACKBAGS

Your child will participate in many group activities in the coming year. Many of the materials listed below will be shared with the class. The experience of contributing materials for the whole class to share helps each child feel like a valued member of the class and helps him or her appreciate the cooperative effort that is necessary to build a learning environment.

- 8 glue sticks (regular size)
- 1 bottle Elmer's white glue
- 3 boxes of Crayola Crayons (original colors- 24 count)

- Scissors (blunt tip)

- 2 Primary Composition books (with the dotted line in the middle)
